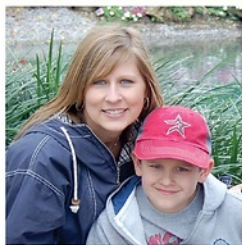


A WORD FROM OUR FOUNDER

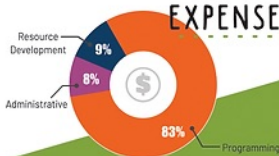
